A Bill With The Amendments

The House of Commons has tonight voted down a range of Labour-supported agriculture bill amendments that had sought to uphold British food and animal welfare standards in future trade deals. The amendments put forward by the House of Lords were all opposed by MPs tonight after a tense debate in which Labour accused the government of only supporting farmers "when the sun shines".

UK Internal Market Bill: key amendments. The government introduced the UK Internal Market Bill to the House of Commons on 9 September 2020. It had four days of committee stage between 15 and 22 September (which took place on the floor of the House) and will pass the House of Commons on 29 September. It is expected to have second reading in the House of Lords in mid-October.

Each House considers the other's amendments When a Bill has passed through third reading in both Houses it is returned to the first House (where it started) for the second House's amendments (proposals for change) to be considered. Both Houses must agree on the exact wording of the Bill.

Consideration of amendments - UK Parliament

An amendment is a change to the wording of a Bill or a motion that is proposed by an MP or member of the House of Lords. Consideration of Amendments is the name for what is often the final stage of Bill. When a Bill has been passed by one House but then is amended by the other House, those amendments must be considered by the first House.

Amendments are proposals to change, remove or add to the existing wording of bills (draft legislation) to modify their effect. Parliament's ability to propose such changes is an important part of the legislative scrutiny process. Different processes apply to amendments to motions. Motions are statements that outline a topic for Parliament to discuss or a question for it to decide.

The US Constitution was written in 1787 and ratified in 1788. In 1791, the Bill of Rights was also ratified with 10 amendments. Since then, 17 more amendments have been added. The amendments deal with a variety of rights ranging from freedom of speech to the right to vote.

Amendment 1 - Freedom of Religion, Speech, and the Press Congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of religion or prohibiting the free exercise thereof , or abridging the freedom of speech or of the press , or the right of the people peaceably to assemble and to petition the government for a redress of grievances .

Thirty-three amendments to the United States Constitution have been proposed by the United States Congress and sent to the states for ratification since the Constitution was put into operation on March 4, 1789. Twenty-seven of these, having been ratified by the requisite number of states, are part of the Constitution.
