Annual tuition fees for international postgraduate students started from as little as £5,000 (US \$6,263), rising to as much as £35,750 (US \$44,777), or £47,100 (US \$57,894) for medical degrees and £57,200 (US \$71,643) for MBAs. But as with undergraduate fees, the majority of postgraduate courses at most universities charged between £12,000 - £20,000 (US \$15,030 - \$25,050) in 2019/20\*.
